- Support the polymer finishing technicians by ensuring all skinergy and silicone gloves are to the required standard
- Work with and be responsible for using specialist machinery ensuring you are fully trained and a competent person to use such machinery at all times; this may involve setting up the machinery, production, maintenance and quality control checks.
